A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Alzheimer's disease
- 2 is a large and growing epidemic that has a huge impact in
- 3 Hawaii. More than six million Americans are currently living
- 4 with Alzheimer's disease, a figure expected to reach 12.7
- 5 million in 2050. In 2019, Alzheimer's disease was the sixth
- 6 leading cause of death in the United States, with deaths from
- 7 the disease having risen by one hundred forty-five per cent
- 8 between 2000 and 2019.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the impact of
- 10 Alzheimer's disease in Hawaii is projected to rise. According
- 11 to data from the Alzheimer's Association, 29,000 people aged
- 12 sixty-five and older are living with Alzheimer's disease, 6.7
- 13 per cent of people aged forty-five and older have subjective
- 14 cognitive decline, and 52,000 family caregivers bear the burden
- 15 of caring for someone with Alzheimer's disease in Hawaii. In
- 16 2020, Hawaii family members and friends of individuals living
- 17 with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia provided

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- 1 eighty-three million hours of care at an economic value of
- 2 nearly \$1,700,000,000.
- 3 The legislature additionally finds that one-third of
- 4 recipients of home health care and adult day care have
- 5 Alzheimer's disease. The average per-person medicaid spending
- 6 for seniors with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia
- 7 is twenty-three times greater than the average per-person
- 8 medicaid spending across all seniors without dementia. In
- 9 total, caring for people with Alzheimer's disease generated an
- 10 estimated medicaid cost of \$59,000,000,000 in 2021. Between
- 11 2020 and 2025, thirty states will see medicaid spending on
- 12 people with Alzheimer's disease increase by at least twenty per
- 13 cent, before adjusting for inflation. By 2050, medicaid
- 14 spending on those with Alzheimer's disease will total an
- 15 estimated \$199,000,000,000, based on current dollars.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 17 (1) Establish and appropriate funds for a working group to
- 18 plan and implement a public health campaign for
- 19 Alzheimer's awareness; and
- 20 (2) Appropriate funds for an Alzheimer's disease and
- 21 related dementias public health campaign.

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1 SECTION 2. (a) There is established the Alzheimer's 2 working group within the department of health for administrative 3 purposes. The working group shall plan and implement a public 4 health campaign for awareness of Alzheimer's disease and other 5 related dementias. 6 The Alzheimer's working group shall be comprised of 7 the following members or their designees: 8 (1)The director of health; The executive director of the executive office on 9 (2)10 aging; 11 (3)The executive director of the Alzheimer's Association; 12 and 13 (4)The executive director of AARP. 14 In planning for the public health campaign for (C) 15 Alzheimer's awareness and other related dementias, the 16 Alzheimer's working group shall include materials to educate the 17 public on: 18 The early signs of cognitive impairment; (1)19 The value of early detection and diagnosis; and (2)

The importance of discussing with health care

professionals any changes in memory and thinking.

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- 1 (d) The Alzheimer's working group shall submit a report of
- 2 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 3 legislation, to the legislature no later than January 1, 2024.
- 4 The report shall include a media campaign with deliverables from
- 5 member organizations of the working group, a proposed budget for
- 6 each deliverable, and a proposed timeline to execute the planned
- 7 activities of the media campaign.
- **8** (e) The Alzheimer's working group shall dissolve on
- 9 December 31, 2025.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for
- 13 the purposes of the Alzheimer's working group established by
- 14 this Act.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for
- 20 the executive office on aging of the department of health to

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1 create an Alzheimer's disease and related dementias public 2 health campaign to educate the public on: 3 (1)The early signs of cognitive impairment; 4 (2) The value of early detection and diagnosis; and 5 (3) The importance of discussing with health care professionals any changes in memory and thinking. 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive 8 office on aging for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
