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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$42,292,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-  
6 fourth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Ma'ili elementary school

8 Plans, design, and construction for

9 renovation of the kindergarten

10 restrooms consisting of twelve

11 restrooms/stalls located in A-Building.

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13	Design	\$25,000
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14	Construction	\$300,000
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15	Total funding	\$350,000
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1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 2. Nānāikapono elementary school

4 Construction for renovations to all of  
5 the boys' and girls' restrooms.

6 Construction \$30,000

7 Total funding \$30,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 3. Nānāikapono elementary school

11 Equipment and appurtenances for a small  
12 bus to pick up students without  
13 transportation to ensure equitable  
14 access to education.

15 Equipment \$115,000

16 Total funding \$115,000

17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
18 shall be expended by the department of education.

19 4. Nānāikapono elementary school

20 Equipment and appurtenances for  
21 installation of four water bottle fill



1 stations located in L-Building corridor  
 2 (one station); A-Building (three  
 3 stations--one in the administration  
 4 wing; one in student support center;  
 5 one in A-Building corridor).

6	Equipment	\$12,000	
7	Total funding		\$12,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 5. Nānāikapono elementary school

11 Plans and equipment and appurtenances  
 12 for landscaping for the front and back  
 13 entrance, including a new sprinkler  
 14 system for the campus.

15	Plans	\$15,000	
16	Equipment	\$70,000	
17	Total funding		\$85,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 19 shall be expended by the department of education.

20 6. Nānākuli elementary school



1 Construction for exterior and interior  
 2 painting of the school due to the age  
 3 of the paint and wear and tear from the  
 4 external elements such as wind, sea  
 5 water, heat, and sun.

6	Construction	\$1,000,000
7	Total funding	\$1,000,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 7. Nānākuli elementary school  
 11 Equipment and appurtenances for  
 12 installation of an irrigation system  
 13 for the upper field.

14	Equipment	\$500,000
15	Total funding	\$500,000

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 17 shall be expended by the department of education.

18 8. Nānākuli elementary school  
 19 Equipment and appurtenances for  
 20 upgrades to the lighting system for the  
 21 cafeteria, office, and library.



1	Equipment	\$200,000
2	Total funding	\$200,000

3       The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
4 shall be expended by the department of education.

5 9.   Nānākuli high and intermediate school  
6       Design, construction, and equipment and  
7       appurtenances for a performing arts  
8       center at Nānākuli high and  
9       intermediate school.

10	Design	\$5,000,000
11	Construction	\$34,000,000
12	Equipment	\$1,000,000
13	Total funding	\$40,000,000

14       The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16       SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
19 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
20 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.


21       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
