BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2	to the state foundation on culture and the arts creative
3	workforce grant program for the awarding of \$25,000 grants to
4	eligible nonprofit arts and culture organizations to support the
5	living wage of one or more salaried staff or contractual
6	personnel in a creative worker role within the organization.
7	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
9	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
10	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
11	year 2024-2025 for the state foundation on culture and the arts
12	creative workforce grant program for the awarding of \$25,000
13	grants to eligible nonprofit arts and culture organizations to
14	support the living wage of one or more salaried staff or
15	contractual personnel in a creative worker role within the
16	organization.
