
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to the state foundation on culture and the arts artist
3 fellowship program for the awarding of one-time fellowships to
4 promising artists in the amount of no less than \$25,000 per
5 fellowship.

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
9 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2024-2025 for the state foundation on culture and the arts
11 artist fellowship program for the awarding of one-time
12 fellowships to promising artists in the amount of no less than
13 \$25,000 per fellowship.

14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the state
15 foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
