

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$114,850,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-  
6 sixth representative district, as follows:

7 1. August Ahrens elementary school

8 Design and construction for covered  
9 outdoor learning spaces; ground and  
10 site improvements; equipment and  
11 appurtenances.

12 Design \$2,000,000

13 Construction \$2,000,000

14 Equipment \$500,000

15 Total funding \$4,500,000

3 2.   August Ahrens elementary school

16 10. Waipahu high school

17 Construction for campus-wide exterior  
18 repainting and all related work,  
19 including new work and refurbishment,  
20 repair, and renovation; ground and site  
21 improvements.

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
 19 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
