A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that surfing is of
- 2 significant cultural, social, and economic value to the people
- 3 of Hawaii, as well as the many visitors who travel to the State
- 4 for surfing. The legislature recognizes the extraordinary
- 5 accomplishments of Carissa Moore a Palolo resident who won the
- 6 gold medal in the first ever women's surfing competition in the
- 7 2020 Summer Olympic Games in Tokyo and the many other Hawaii
- 8 surfers who have dedicated themselves to honoring and preserving
- 9 the sport and spirit of surfing in Hawaii.
- 10 The legislature additionally finds that since surfing was
- 11 sanctioned by the department of education in 2004, only one of
- 12 five local athletic leagues have sponsored surfing. The lack of
- 13 interscholastic surfing programs limits opportunities for
- 14 inspired students to pursue competitive surfing.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 16 department of education to promote and support surfing as an
- 17 interscholastic sport.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2024-2025 for the promotion and support of surfing as an
- 6 interscholastic sport.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
