## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Ko education

  center, formerly known as the north Hawaii education and

  research center, provides accessible education opportunities for

  students from all over the northern part of Hawaii island and

- 15 have been performed by the center's director, temporary hires,
- 16 and casual help from student employees. The legislature
