

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 This section shall not prohibit a specialty 4 contractor from taking and executing a contract involving the 5 use of two or more crafts or trades, if the performance of the 6 work in the crafts or trades, other than in which the specialty 7 contractor is licensed, is incidental and supplemental [to the 8 performance of] work [in the craft for which the specialty 9 contractor is licensed]. 10 For purposes of this subsection, "incidental and supplemental work" means work done in other trades directly 11 12 related to and necessary for the completion of the project 13 undertaken by a specialty contractor licensee pursuant to the 14 scope of the licensee's license; provided that the work shall 15 not exceed five per cent of the specialty contractor licensee's 16 total work on the project."
