A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RESTRICTIONS ON AGRICULTURAL USES AND ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 205-4.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Agricultural uses and activities as defined in
 sections 205-2(d) and 205-4.5(a) on lands classified as
 agricultural shall not be restricted by any private agreement
 contained in any:
- 7 (1)Deed, agreement of sale, or other conveyance of land 8 recorded in the bureau of conveyances after July 8, 9 2003, that subjects the agricultural lands to any 10 servitude, including but not limited to covenants, 11 easements, or equitable and reciprocal negative 12 servitudes; provided that any private agreement 13 contained in a conveyance of land recorded on or 14 before July 8, 2003, that:
 - (A) Limits or prohibits agricultural use or activity;and

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1		(B) Is renewed and recorded in the bureau of
2		conveyances after July 8, 2003,
3		shall be considered a new private agreement that is
4		subject to the prohibition on agricultural use and
5		activity restrictions under this section; provided
6		further that any provision in a private agreement
7		contained in a conveyance of land recorded on or
8		before July 8, 2003, that limits or prohibits
9		agricultural use or activity and has since expired but
10		has not been renewed and recorded in the bureau of
11		conveyances shall be void; and
12	(2)	Condominium declaration, map, bylaws, and other
13		documents executed and submitted in accordance with
14		chapter 514B or any predecessor thereto.
15	Any priva	te restriction limiting or prohibiting agricultural use
16	or activity shall be voidable, subject to special restrictions	
17	enacted by the county ordinance pursuant to section 46-4; except	
18	that restrictions taken to protect environmental or cultural	
19	resources, agricultural leases, utility easements, and access	
20	easements shall not be subject to this section."

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Report Title:

Agricultural Lands; Expired Private Agreements; Restrictions

Description:

Clarifies that any provision in a private agreement contained in a conveyance of land recorded on or before 7/8/2003 that have since expired but have not been renewed and recorded in the bureau of conveyances are prohibited from restricting bona fide agricultural uses and activities on agricultural land.

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
