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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OHANA ZONES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                   or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and  
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
5 year 2024-2025 for the ohana zones pilot program established  
6 pursuant to Act 209, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, as amended by  
7 Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended by Act 235,  
8 Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, including expenses relating to  
9 operations, upkeep of facilities, provision of services, and  
10 administrative costs.

11           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of  
12 the governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the  
13 governor shall transfer the expenditure authority to designated  
14 executive branch departments or agencies within a reasonable  
15 time.

16           The appropriations made by this Act shall not lapse at the  
17 end of the fiscal years for which the appropriations are made;



1 provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

3 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the governor  
4 may transfer all or a portion of the appropriation in this  
5 section to the governor's designated executive branch agencies  
6 for expenditures incurred in implementing the ohana zones pilot  
7 program.

8 The governor's designated executive branch agencies may  
9 expend any appropriation transferred pursuant to this section  
10 for the performance of its duties under the ohana zones pilot  
11 program.

12 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
13 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much  
14 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
15 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
16 for the purpose of constructing or rehabilitating facilities  
17 that will result in new units for the ohana zones pilot program  
18 established pursuant to Act 209, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, as  
19 amended by Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended by  
20 Act 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022; provided that:



1           (1) The appropriation made for the capital improvement  
2           project authorized by this section shall not lapse at  
3           the end of the fiscal biennium for which the  
4           appropriation is made; and

5           (2) All moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as of  
6           June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

7           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the  
8           governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the  
9           governor shall transfer the expenditure authority to designated  
10          executive branch departments or agencies within a reasonable  
11          time.

12          Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the governor  
13          may transfer all or a portion of the appropriation in this  
14          section to the governor's designated executive branch agencies  
15          for expenditures incurred in implementing the ohana zones pilot  
16          program.

17          The governor's designated executive branch agencies may  
18          expend any appropriation transferred pursuant to this section  
19          for the performance of its duties under the ohana zones pilot  
20          program.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
