A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that collective
- 2 bargaining unit (5) includes public school teachers and other
- 3 personnel employed by public charter schools under the same pay
- 4 schedule in Hawaii. Yet, section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 5 does not explicitly mention charter schools, creating confusion
- $\mathbf{6}$ about the extent to which charter school teachers and other
- 7 personnel are included under the State's collective bargaining
- 8 laws.
- 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify that
- 10 public charter school teachers and other personnel employed by
- 11 public charter schools under the same pay schedule are part of
- 12 collective bargaining unit (5), along with public school
- 13 teachers and other personnel employed under the same pay
- 14 schedule by the department of education.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

20	(10)	Institutional, health, and correctional workers;
