### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 11-410, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:

4 "(b) Any order for the assessment of an administrative 5 fine shall not be issued against a person without providing the 6 person written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a hearing conducted under chapter 91. A person may waive these 7 8 rights by written stipulation or consent. These rights shall be 9 deemed waived if the order is a preliminary determination of probable cause rendered during a chapter 92 meeting pursuant to 10 11 section 11-403 and the person fails to request a contested case hearing within twenty days of receipt of the preliminary 12 13 determination, as provided in section 11-405(b)." 14 2. By amending subsection (d) to read: 15 "(d) If the person to whom the commission's order is directed does not comply with the order, the first circuit 16 court, upon application of the commission, shall issue an order 17

2	Failure to obey such a court order shall be punished as
3	contempt. In addition to contempt proceedings, the commission
4	may file the commission's order in the first circuit court to
5	have the order confirmed as a judgment, which shall then have
6	the same force and effect and shall be enforceable and
7	collectible in the same manner as other judgments issued by the
8	circuit courts; provided that there shall be no appeal from the
9	judgment."
