A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACCESS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH PRINT DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the public utilities
- 2 commission has a duty and obligation to obtain and maintain
- 3 access to a basic set of essential telecommunications services
- 4 for individuals who are blind or visually impaired.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 6 public utilities commission to provide free telecommunications
- 7 access to certain information for persons with a print
- 8 disability.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the public
- 10 utilities commission special fund the sum of \$150,000 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 13 2024-2025 to provide free telecommunications access to certain
- 14 information for persons with a print disability.
- 15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the public
- 16 utilities commission for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
