

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 235-55.75, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Each qualifying individual taxpayer may claim a
- 4 refundable earned income tax credit. The tax credit, for the
- 5 appropriate taxable year, shall be [twenty] per cent of the
- 6 federal earned income tax credit allowed and properly claimed
- 7 under section 32 of the Internal Revenue Code and reported as
- 8 such on the individual's federal income tax return."
- 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
- 12 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2022.
