

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CONDUCT AN ANALYSIS REGARDING THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE FOR ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS.

1	WHEREAS, this body recognizes that there is a physician		
2	shortage in the State, which often makes it challenging for		
3	rural communities to access health care; and		
4 5	WHEREAS, advanced practice registered nurses and physician		
6	assistants are vital health care professionals who are capable		
7	of filling in some of the gaps in access to health care in the		
8	State; and

10 11	WHEREAS, various measures have been introduced during the		
11	past regular sessions of the Legislature that have proposed expanding the scope of practice for advanced practice registered		
13	nurses and physician assistants; and		
14			
15	WHEREAS, there is a need to clearly distinguish the scope		
16 17	of practice of advanced practice registered nurses and physician		
17 18	assistants and determine the appropriate scope of practice for each of these professions in the State to better complement the		
19	work of physicians; now, therefore,

21	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the		
22	Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular		
23 24	Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative		
24 25	Reference Bureau is requested to conduct an analysis regarding the scope of practice for advanced practice registered nurses		
26	and physician assistants; and

28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference		
29	Bureau is requested to analyze whether each scope of practice
