
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION AND HAWAII'S
CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO TAKE ANY ACTIONS NECESSARY TO
ESTABLISH AN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER AT LANAI AIRPORT.

1 WHEREAS, as both general aviation and commercial aircraft
2 traffic increase, managing and separating air traffic flows
3 becomes increasingly important; and

4
5 WHEREAS, to that end, air traffic control towers have been
6 established at airports throughout the world to ensure the safe,
7 orderly, and efficient flow of traffic on and around the
8 airport; and

10 WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration is authorized
11 to establish or discontinue air traffic control towers through
12 the National Airspace System if activity levels and safety
13 considerations justify the action; and

15 WHEREAS, Lanai Airport served more than one hundred
16 thousand passengers during the year ending December 2022; and

18 WHEREAS, nevertheless, Lanai Airport lacks an air traffic
19 control tower; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
23 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Federal
24 Aviation Administration and Hawaii's congressional delegation
25 are urged to take any actions necessary to establish an air
26 traffic control tower at Lanai airport; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Administrator of the


