11 12 13 14 15 16	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to research and compile a list of laws applicable to the protection of students; and	
17 18 19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the list of laws include laws, ordinances, and rules that:	
20 21	(1)	Specifically prohibit or require actions on school grounds or within a specified distance of a school;
22 23 24	(2)	Address offenses under chapter 707, part V, Hawaii Revised Statutes, related to sexual offenses;
25 26 27	(3)	Prohibit vandalism;

Involve traffic violations that could occur near 1 (4) 2 schools; 3 (5) Prohibit theft; or 4 5 (6) 6 Address sitting or lying down in public spaces; and 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to draft a school laws summary that: 9 10 11 (1)Summarizes each applicable law in a manner that is easy for members of the public to understand; and 12 13 Can be used by first responders and community groups 14 (2) to protect students while they are on or near schools; 15 16 and 17 18 by the beginning of the 2024 Regular Session, distribute the school laws summary to state and county offices and make it 19 easily accessible to download from State and county websites; 20 21 and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to develop a separate list or guidance on 24 how to maintain and update the school laws summary; and 25 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to submit a report on its progress of 28 29 drafting and distributing the school laws summary and proposed 30 legislation, if any, no later than twenty days before the 31 Regular Session of 2024; and 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Attorney General, 34 Superintendent of Education, Chiefs of Police of the county 35 police departments, Prosecuting Attorneys of each of the 36 37 counties, and Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness. 38 39 40 41
