## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HAWAII-TAIWAN FRIENDSHIP  
TASKFORCE TO EXPLORE WAYS TO STRENGTHEN, IMPROVE, AND  
EXPAND ECONOMIC, CULTURAL, AND EDUCATIONAL RELATIONS  
BETWEEN HAWAII AND TAIWAN.

1           WHEREAS, Taiwan shares with the United States the universal  
2 values of freedom, democracy, and respect for human rights and  
3 the rule of law; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, Taiwan and Hawaii have an established sister-state  
6 relationship since 1993, and sister-city or sister-county  
7 relationships have been established between Honolulu and  
8 Kaohsiung City, Maui County and Pingtung County, Hawaii County  
9 and Hualien County, and Kauai County and Penghu County; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii Office in Taipei and the  
12 Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Honolulu have worked  
13 together to promote cooperation and exchanges in tourism,  
14 agriculture, culture, education, and trade; and  
15

16           WHEREAS, Taiwan's export and import volume reached  
17 \$500,000,000,000 and \$300,000,000,000, respectively, in 2022,  
18 and the International Monetary Fund ranks Taiwan as the twenty-  
19 second largest economy in the world; and  
20

21           WHEREAS, before the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic,  
22 Taiwanese citizens made over seventeen million trips abroad; and

24           WHEREAS, with loosening travel restrictions, there is  
25 tremendous potential for Taiwanese visitors to Hawaii to further  
26 help revitalize Hawaii's tourism sector; and

1 WHEREAS, in 2021, Taiwan was Hawaii's tenth-largest trade  
2 partner, with exports to Hawaii totaling \$54,000,000, and  
3 imports from Hawaii totaling \$13,000,000; now, therefore,  
4

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
6 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
7 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Office of the  
8 Governor is requested to establish a Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship  
9 Taskforce; and  
10

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship  
12 Taskforce is requested to explore ways to strengthen, improve,  
13 and expand economic, cultural, and educational relations between  
14 Hawaii and Taiwan; and  
15

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship  
17 Taskforce is requested to comprise nine members as follows:  
18

- 19 (1) Three members appointed by the Governor;
- 20
- 21 (2) Three members appointed by the President of the  
22 Senate; and

- 24 (3) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
25 Representatives; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the  
28 Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship Taskforce are requested to elect a  
29 chair and vice chair from among the members; and  
30

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship  
32 Taskforce is requested to submit a report of its findings and  
33 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the  
34 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
35 the Regular Session of 2025; and  
36

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship  
38 Taskforce shall cease to exist on June 30, 2025; and

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
41 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and
