HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE JUDICIARY TO PREPARE A MASTER DEVELOPMENT PLAN, INCLUDING A CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT REQUEST, TO UPGRADE THE SOUTH KOHALA DISTRICT COURT.

WHEREAS, the South Kohala District Court complex is located 1 2 in Waimea, which is a one-hour drive from both Hilo and Kona, the two larger population centers on Hawaii island; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the population of Waimea has nearly doubled in 5 twenty years from seven thousand to nearly fourteen thousand 6 residents; and 7 8 WHEREAS, neighboring communities in North Kohala, Kawaihae, 9 Waikoloa, Hamakua, Waikii, and the South Kohala Coast rely on 10 crucial government services in Waimea, including access to the 11 District Court; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Waimea needs a bigger District Court complex, a 14 District Court Judge, and Circuit Court Judge to serve the large 15 geographical area and its growing population; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the current complex does not have adequate seating 18 capacity and people often must wait outside; some days as many 19 as fifty individuals are forced to wait outside; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Waimea is at nearly a two thousand seven hundred-22 23 foot elevation level and is exposed to trade winds and rain; and 24 WHEREAS, the restroom facilities are inadequate with just 25 one male and one female restroom, with one stall each, and are 26 located within the security check point and not easily 27 28 accessible to the parties waiting outside; and 29

WHEREAS, the public has been told that they cannot file 1 family court documents at the South Kohala District Court, 2 forcing them to go to either Hilo or Kona; and 3 4 WHEREAS, for temporary restraining order cases, there is no 5 separate waiting area for the opposing parties, which creates 6 stressful, if not dangerous, situations in which the opposing 7 parties may encounter each other outside of the courtroom; and 8 9 WHEREAS, this serious lack of judiciary facilities in South 10 Kohala can only be remedied by an objective evaluation of the 11 demand for these facilities and a determination of how these 12 needs can be met; and 13 14 WHEREAS, this evaluation and analysis would provide the 15 necessary information to prepare a master development plan to 16 upgrade the South Kohala District Court complex; now, therefore, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 20 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Judiciary is 21 requested to prepare a master development plan for the South 22 Kohala District Court complex, including a cost estimate to 23 plan, design, and construct the upgraded facility as a capital 24 improvement project; and 25 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judiciary is requested to submit a capital improvement project request for the planning, 28 design, and construction for an upgraded South Kohala District 29 Court to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the 30 convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and 31 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 33 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chief Justice and 34 Administrator Director of the Courts. 35 36 37 Oar 38 OFFERED BY:
