## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS, TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON PROVIDING TAX BREAKS TO INDIVIDUALS WHO SELL PROPERTY TO NATIVE HAWAIIANS ON THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS WAITLIST.

WHEREAS, the availability of housing in the State, 1 especially for native Hawaiians, has been a long-standing 2 concern; and 3 4 WHEREAS, in 2017 the United States Department of Housing 5 and Urban Development released the "Housing Needs of Native 6 Hawaiians" report that compares housing conditions of native 7 Hawaiians to those of other residents of the State; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the report found that native Hawaiians are disproportionately represented in the State's homeless 11 population; and 12 13 WHEREAS, native Hawaiians continue to make up a large 14 percentage of that State's homeless population; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, in 2022, native Hawaiians made up forty-four percent of the State's homeless population, with fifteen percent 18 of those homeless individuals reporting that they were on the 19 Department of Hawaiian Home Land's waitlist for a homestead 20 21 property; 22 23 WHEREAS, there are approximately 28,700 native Hawaiian applicants on the Department of Hawaiian Home Land's homestead 24 waitlist; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for more affordable housing for native Hawaiians not only on homestead land, but 28 29 throughout the State; and 30

WHEREAS, the State needs innovative solutions to address 1 socio-economic problems faced by native Hawaiians and to put 2 native Hawaiians into affordable housing; now, therefore, 3 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 6 Session of 2023, that the Department of Taxation, in 7 8 consultation with the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, is urged to conduct a feasibility study on providing tax breaks to 9 individuals who sell property to native Hawaiians who are listed 10 on the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands waitlist; and 11 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Taxation is 14 requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 15 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 16 the Regular Session of 2024; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Director of Taxation and 20 21 Chairperson of the Hawaiian Homes Commission. 22 23 OFFERED BY: C. 2 24
