HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO EXAMINE ORGANIC PESTICIDES FOR AUTHORIZED USE IN THE STATE.

WHEREAS, in recent years, organic pesticides have emerged 1 2 as a popular alternative to conventional synthetic pesticides; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, organic pesticides usually come from natural 6 sources, such as plants, minerals, or microorganisms, and are 7 minimally processed; and 8 9 WHEREAS, many farmers prefer organic pesticides over synthetic alternatives because organic pesticides typically 10 break down faster in the environment, leaving no residual 11 activity after a relatively short time; and 12 13 WHEREAS, organic pesticides, particularly biological 14 insecticides, can also be selective in the types of pests 15 controlled, which reduces potential harm to non-target species 16 such as pollinators and other beneficial insects; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Hawaii has been impacted by various agricultural 19 20 diseases and invasive species that threaten the State's agricultural industries; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, identifying organic pesticides that can bolster Hawaii's agricultural sustainability while minimizing lasting 24 environmental effects is a worthwhile endeavor; and 25 26 WHEREAS, currently, pesticide manufacturers, and other 27 authorized individuals, must submit an application to the 28 29 Department of Agriculture to license pesticides for use in the State; and 30 31

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture should be more 1 proactive in finding safe, organic pesticides for Hawaii's local 2 farmers; now, therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 5 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 6 7 Session of 2023, that the Department of Agriculture is requested 8 to: 9 10 (1)Study organic pesticides that are currently licensed or authorized for use in the State; and 11 12 (2) Find organic pesticides that are not currently 13 licensed or authorized for use, or otherwise 14 15 prohibited, in the State, and test those organic pesticides for authorized use in the State; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 18 is requested to submit a report of its findings and 19 recommendations regarding organic pesticides, including any 20 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty 21 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 24 25 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Agriculture. 26 27 28 OFFERED BY: Ce ae 29
