HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING EACH COUNTY TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE INTEGRATED WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AND FINANCIAL STRATEGY TO UPGRADE OR CONVERT CESSPOOLS LOCATED WITHIN ITS RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION BY 2050.

WHEREAS, there are approximately eighty-three thousand 1 cesspools across the State, with 48,596 on the island of Hawaii; 2 14,300 on Kauai; 11,038 on Maui; 7,491 on Oahu; and 1,400 on 3 Molokai; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, requires 6 every cesspool in the State, excluding cesspools granted 7 8 exemptions by the Director of Health, to be upgraded or converted to a Director-approved wastewater system or connected 9 to a sewerage system by January 1, 2050; and 10 11 WHEREAS, according to the Cesspool Conversion Working Group 12 Final Report to the 2023 Regular Session Legislature, the cost 13 of conversions to most private and residential property owners 14 15 is significant, ranging from an estimated collective total of \$880,000,000 to more than \$5,300,000,000, with only three 16 17 percent of all residents unburdened by the cost to convert; and 18 WHEREAS, many properties in rural areas, especially on the 19 neighbor islands, may not be in areas where existing county 20 infrastructure allows for easy conversion and connection to 21 sewer systems; and 22 23 WHEREAS, undertaking a massive infrastructure project, such 24 as converting eighty-three thousand cesspools by 2050, requires 25 proper planning and administration across various stakeholders 26 and governmental institutions, including those of the counties; 27 now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 30 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 31 Session of 2023, that each county is requested to develop a 32 comprehensive integrated wastewater management plan and 33

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financial strategy to upgrade or convert cesspools located 1 within its respective jurisdiction by 2050; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each county is requested to 4 5 include the following information in its comprehensive integrated wastewater management plan and financial strategy: 6 7 Planned connections to both centralized public and 8 (1)9 private treatment systems; 10 Locations where individualized treatment systems will (2)11 be needed; 12 13 14 (3) Locations where smaller-scale cluster treatment systems may be utilized; 15 16 Individual treatment system needs for homes having (4) 17 cesspools, including whether there is appropriate 18 existing infrastructure capacity to handle the 19 conversion of cesspools by 2050; and 20 21 Financial needs, funding mechanisms, and financing (5) 22 strategies to assist with cesspool conversions; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each county is requested to 25 submit its respective comprehensive integrated wastewater 26 management plan and financial strategy, including any proposed 27 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior 28 to the convening of the regular session of 2024; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health, Mayor of 32 the City and County of Honolulu, Mayor of the County of Hawaii, 33 Mayor of the County of Maui, and Mayor of the County of Kauai. 34 35 OFFERED BY: Viele E 36 37

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
