CONGRATULATING THE 2023 UNITED STATES SENATE YOUTH PROGRAM DELEGATES, PHI THETA KAPPA HONOR SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL CO-PRESIDENT, AND 2023 LIFESMARTS CONSUMER EDUCATION COMPETITION SECOND PLACE RECIPIENTS.

1 WHEREAS, DANIEL PRUDER was recently selected as a 2023
2 United States Senate Youth Program delegate; and

4 WHEREAS, DANIEL PRUDER is a senior at Punahou School and
5 the leader of Punahou's Model UN and Civic Engagement clubs,
6 while also being an active member of the Punahou theatre
7 program; he has served on the Honolulu Youth Commission
8 representing District 5 since the commission began in 2021,
9 first as Vice-Chair and currently as Chair; and

11 WHEREAS, DANIEL PRUDER has interned with the office of
12 former Lieutenant Governor Josh Green and Honolulu City Council
13 member Calvin Say; he also volunteered with the first
14 legislative committee of Vot16HI, which seeks to lower the
15 statewide voting age to 16; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to his admirable public service
18 contributions, DANIEL PRUDER was named an Outstanding Advocate
19 for Children and Youth during the 2022 Hawai'i Children and Youth
20 Day celebration and received the Mayor's Award of Recognition
21 for his appointment to the Honolulu Youth Commission; and

23 WHEREAS, MAVERICK YASUDA was recently selected as a 2023
24 United States Senate Youth Program delegate; and

26 WHEREAS, a senior at Waipahu High School, MAVERICK YASUDA
27 is an exceptional academic who plans on receiving an associate
28 degree in liberal arts upon graduating from high school; and

2 WHEREAS, MAVERICK YASUDA is a member of the student
3 government, Phi Theta Kappa collegiate honor society, and Ivy
4 League club and serves as the vice president of the school's
5 Academy of Natural Resources; and

7 WHEREAS, beyond the classroom, MAVERICK YASUDA is the
8 student member of the Hawai'i State Board of Education,
9 representing 168,000 public school students throughout the
10 State; in addition to his remarkable service efforts, he
11 received the Outstanding Advocate for Children and Youth award
12 during the 2022 Hawai'i Children and Youth Day celebration; and

14 WHEREAS, KEZIAH CHRISTIE UNCIANO ANCHETA was recently
15 selected as the International Co-President of the Phi Theta
16 Kappa Honor Society; and

18 WHEREAS, KEZIAH CHRISTIE UNCIANO ANCHETA is a dually
19 enrolled student at Waipahu High School and the University of
20 Hawai'i through the early college program; she will receive an
21 Associate in Arts degree with a certificate in business
22 management from Leeward Community College upon graduation; and

24 WHEREAS, serving in several leadership roles, KEZIAH
25 CHRISTIE UNCIANO ANCHETA is a representative for the Hawai'i
26 State Student Council and the Public Relations Officer for the
27 Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps; and

29 WHEREAS, KEZIAH CHRISTIE UNCIANO ANCHETA was also appointed
30 by the Mayor to the Honolulu Youth Commission and serves as its
31 Secretary while advising the Mayor and County Council on issues
32 concerning Honolulu's youth; and

34 WHEREAS, KEZIAH CHRISTIE UNCIANO ANCHETA has been a proud
35 member of Waipahu's Phi Theta Kappa Beta Chi Omega Chapter and
36 served as the 2021-2022 Phi Theta Kappa Pacific Region
37 President; in her current role as International Co-President of
38 the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, she is the first dually
39 enrolled student and youngest person to serve as an
40 international officer; and




1 WHEREAS, WAIPAHU HIGH SCHOOL'S TEAM 1 recently earned
