HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF WIDENING THE PORTION OF UNIVERSITY AVENUE BETWEEN MAILE WAY AND OAHU AVENUE.

WHEREAS, Manoa Valley is a residential neighborhood of 1 Honolulu and has eighteen thousand six hundred households, a 2 3 population of 46,865, and a non-resident workforce of 25,230; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley is also home to the University of 6 Hawaii at Manoa, Mid-Pacific Institute, Noelani and Manoa 7 elementary schools, four private schools, sixty-three general 8 businesses, eighteen clubs and associations, twenty-five 9 community service entities, eighteen faith-based organizations, 10 fourteen health care centers, fourteen nonprofit organizations, 11 and nine kupuna care centers; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley ingress and egress is limited to two 15 roads: Manoa Road and University Avenue; and 16 WHEREAS, each day, bicycles and motor vehicles, including 17 18 buses, firetrucks, ambulances, commercial vehicles, and passenger vehicles, travel on University Avenue, creating a 19 significant traffic safety concern; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley contains three heavily used hiking 23 trails, Manoa Falls trail, Puu Pia trail, and Kolowalu trail, resulting in the valley being Oahu's second most frequented 24 destination by visitors and residents, further exacerbating 25 26 traffic congestion throughout the valley; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley District Park, the second most used 29 city park on Oahu, hosts a myriad of events; sports activities such as baseball, softball, soccer, tennis, pickleball, 30 31 volleyball, basketball, and swimming; summer fun programs;

1 senior citizen programs; open markets; community gardening; and disaster preparedness programs; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, there exists an immediate need to improve traffic 5 safety throughout Manoa Valley; and 6 7 WHEREAS, one possible way to alleviate traffic congestion 8 and improve traffic safety in Manoa Valley is to widen the portion of University Avenue between Maile Way and Oahu Avenue; 9 now, therefore, 10 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 13 Session of 2023, that the Department of Transportation Services 14 of the City and County of Honolulu is urged to conduct a 15 16 feasibility study of widening the portion of University Avenue between Maile Way and Oahu Avenue; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is 20 21 also requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 22 23 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 24 the regular session of 2024; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 27 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu. 28 29 30 31 OFFERED BY:
