A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE DELIVERY OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 323F-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending the definition of "private entity" to read
3	as follow	s:
4	""Private entity" means a business organization duly	
5	authorize	d to transact business in the State that:
6	(1)	Has a certificate of need or license to operate one or
7		more [licensed hospitals in the State obtained from
8		the state health planning and development agency
9		pursuant to part V of chapter 323D; community
10		hospitals or hospitals serving a rural population
11		licensed under the laws of any state; or
12	(2)	Is the sole member of a nonprofit management entity or
13		hospital that has a certificate of need or license to
14		operate one or more [licensed hospitals in the State
15		obtained from the state health planning and
16		development agency pursuant to part V of chapter

1	323D.] community hospitals or hospitals serving a
2	rural population licensed under the laws of any
3	state."
4	SECTION 2. Section 323F-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"[+]\$323F-52[+] Transfer of right and responsibility to
7	manage, operate, and provide health care services in a facility
8	of the Maui regional system to a nonprofit management entity.
9	(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, including
10	but not limited to section $27-1[_{\tau}]_{\underline{;}}$ section $76-16(b)$ and other
11	sections of chapter $76[\tau]$; chapters 78 , 89 , $89A$, $89C$, and
12	$171[_{7}]_{\underline{i}}$ part V of chapter $323D[_{7}]_{\underline{i}}$ and sections $323F-11$ and
13	323F-31, the governor, with the assistance of the chief
14	executive officer of the corporation, and the regional chief
15	executive officer of the Maui regional system, or their
16	designees, shall negotiate with a private entity to transfer the
17	right and responsibility to manage, operate and otherwise
18	provide health care services at one or more facilities of the
19	Maui regional system, including Maui memorial medical center,
20	Kula hospital and clinic, and Lanai community hospital, to a
21	nonprofit management entity wholly-owned by the private entity;

- 1 provided that the private entity submitted a statement of
- 2 interest in response to a notice published in accordance with
- 3 section 1-28.5 by the Maui regional system board, inviting
- 4 private entities to submit statements of interest in acquiring
- 5 the right and responsibility to manage, operate, and otherwise
- 6 provide health care services in one or more of the Maui regional
- 7 system's facilities.
- 8 (b) Any agreement negotiated by the governor and entered
- 9 into by the private entity and the governor, the corporation
- 10 board, and the Maui regional system board, shall, at minimum,
- 11 include a transfer completion date and a plan and schedule for
- 12 completing the transfer that includes:
- 13 (1) Provisions and deadlines for conducting and completing
- 14 due diligence;
- 15 (2) Provisions and a deadline to terminate the agreement
- before a transfer is completed, at the parties'
- 17 respective option;
- 18 (3) Provisions for winding-down operations at the
- 19 transferred facility or facilities and for terminating
- the agreement in the event that the lease entered into
- 21 pursuant to section 323F-54 is terminated before the

1	lease expires or the private entity or its nonprofit
2	management entity abandons or otherwise discontinues
3	its provision of health care services in a transferred
4	facility; and

- 5 (4) Provisions to transfer or assign interests in 6 equipment and furnishings, including any leases for 7 the same; accounts receivable; medicare and other 8 provider agreements; business and commercial licenses 9 and registrations; intellectual property and goodwill; 10 administrative, financial, and medical records and 11 information; or any other interests or property of the 12 Maui regional system facility or facilities to be 13 transferred under this part, that the parties agree to 14 transfer or assign.
- 15 (c) On and after the transfer completion date for the
 16 transfer of one or more facilities of the Maui regional system
 17 to a private entity or its nonprofit management entity pursuant
 18 to this part, the State, the corporation, and the Maui regional
 19 system and its board shall cease to have any responsibility for
 20 or control over the management and operation of the facility or
 21 facilities transferred by the agreement pursuant to this part.

- 1 (d) Beginning January 1, 2024, before entering into any
- 2 new agreement or modifying or terminating any existing agreement
- 3 entered into pursuant to this part, the chief executive officer
- 4 of the corporation or the chief executive officer's designee
- 5 shall provide the governor with written comments, including any
- 6 representations made by the private entity to the corporation or
- 7 Maui regional system related to the management and operation of
- 8 and provision of health care services at the facility or
- 9 facilities transferred or being transferred by the agreement
- 10 pursuant to this part."
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Report Title:

Hawaii Health Systems Corporation; Maui Regional System Facilities; Public-Private Partnerships; Private Entity; Agreements

Description:

Expands the definition of "private entity" to include business organizations that are authorized to transact business in the State, including nonprofit management entities that have a certificate of need or license to operate one or more community hospitals or hospitals serving a rural population licensed under the laws of any state. Beginning 1/1/2024, require the chief executive officer of the Hawaii health systems corporation to provide written comments to the governor before the State enters into any new agreement with a private entity or modifies or terminates any existing agreement to transfer the right and responsibility to manage, operate and otherwise provide health care services at one or more facilities of the Maui regional system. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

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
