RELATING TO VEHICLE WEIGHT TAXES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 249-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[f] \$249-6.5[f] Exemption for National Guard[, military
- 4 reserves, and other active duty military personnel and veterans
- 5 claiming Hawaii as their residence of record. (a) One
- 6 noncommercial motor vehicle registered to a member of the
- 7 National Guard (, military reserve, or armed service, including
- 8 the Coast Guard, who is:
- 9 (1) Assigned to a unit in the State; and
- 10 (2) A member in good standing,
- 11 shall be exempt from the vehicle weight tax provided for in this
- 12 chapter.
- 13 (b) One noncommercial motor vehicle registered to a
- 14 veteran shall be exempt from the vehicle weight tax provided for
- 15 in this chapter.



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1	(c) For the purposes of this section, "veteran" means any
2	person who has served in any of the armed services of the United
3	States and was not dishonorably discharged."
4	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
