A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXPUNGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 291E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: 4 "
\$291E- First-time offender of operating a vehicle after consuming a measurable amount of alcohol for persons under 5 6 the age of twenty-one years before 1998; expungement. A person sentenced before July 1, 1998, for a first-time offense of 7 8 operating a vehicle after consuming a measurable amount of 9 alcohol while under the age of twenty-one years, pursuant to 10 section 291E-64, and who otherwise meets all the requirements of 11 section 291E-64, may apply to the court for expungement of the 12 record of conviction for the offense. The court shall issue a 13 court order to expunge the record of conviction for the offense; provided that the person has fulfilled the terms of the sentence 14 15 imposed by the court. A person granted an expungement of conviction under this section shall not be eligible for another 16
