A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that traffic-related
- 2 fatalities and injuries are rising, killing and badly injuring
- 3 more Hawaii residents, keiki, and kupuna each year. The federal
- 4 government requires a highway safety advisory board to make
- 5 recommendations to the governor and department of transportation
- 6 to reduce deaths and injuries. However, Hawaii's highway safety
- 7 council has been underutilized, having been convened by the
- 8 department of transportation just once in 2022, in spite of a
- 9 statewide wave of rising injuries and fatalities.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to activate the highway safety
- 11 council to meaningfully address Hawaii's rising fatalities and
- 12 injuries by amending the composition and duties of the state
- 13 highway safety council.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 286-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "§286-5 State highway safety council. (a) There is
- 17 established the Hawaii highway safety council. [The director of



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- 1 transportation shall serve as its chairperson.] The council
- 2 shall be chaired on an annually rotating basis between the
- 3 chairpersons of the respective committees of the house of
- 4 representatives and senate having jurisdiction over
- 5 transportation, or their designees. The following or their
- 6 designated representatives shall be members of the council: the
- 7 chief justice, the attorney general, the director of health,
- 8 the superintendent of education, the president of the University
- 9 of Hawaii, the chairperson of the house of representatives
- 10 standing committee having jurisdiction over transportation, the
- 11 chairperson of the senate standing committee having jurisdiction
- 12 over transportation, the chairperson of each of the county
- 13 highway safety councils established under section 286-6, and not
- 14 more than twenty other persons who shall be appointed by the
- 15 governor on the basis of their interest in [highway]
- 16 transportation safety [-] and related state goals.
- 17 (b) The state highway safety council shall [advise]:
- 18 (1) Review programs, projects, plans, and strategies
- related to improving safety in ground transportation
- in the department of transportation; and

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1	(2) Advise the governor, legislature, and public on
2	matters relating to the programs [and], activities,
3	projects, outcomes, and recommendations of the State
4	in the field of [highway] transportation safety.
5	(c) The members of the council shall serve without pay but
6	shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses while
7	attending meetings and while in discharge of their duties."
8	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
