BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 3 1. By amending subsection (c) to read:
- 4 "(c) Any person who holds a category (1), (2), or (3)
- 5 license issued under this part [who is unable to appear in
- 6 person before the examiner of drivers to apply for a renewal of
- 7 the driver's license, may[7] apply for a renewal of the license
- 8 online via any electronic or digital means provided by the
- 9 examiner of drivers, or by mail, if the person is not
- 10 disqualified from renewing the license under subsection (a)
- 11 except as provided under subsection (h) [, apply for a renewal by
- 12 mail]. The applicant's request to have the license renewed by
- 13 mail must be received by the examiner of drivers within ninety
- 14 days after the expiration of the license or it shall be treated
- 15 as an application for reactivation of an expired license under
- 16 section 286-107.5. The examiner of drivers shall, upon receipt
- 17 of the request, furnish the applicant with all necessary forms

3	assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse certifying that
4	the applicant was examined by the licensed physician, physician

8	examination to have met the physical requirements established by
9	the state director of transportation for the renewal of
