BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (c) to read:

"(c) Any person who holds a category (1), (2), or (3) 4 5 license issued under this part [who is unable to appear in person before the examiner of drivers to apply for a renewal of 6 7 the driver's license, $may[\tau]$ apply for a renewal of the license 8 online via any electronic or digital means provided by the 9 examiner of drivers, or by mail, if the person is not 10 disqualified from renewing the license under subsection (a) 11 except as provided under subsection (h) [, apply for a renewal by 12 mail]. The applicant's request to have the license renewed by 13 mail must be received by the examiner of drivers within ninety 14 days after the expiration of the license or it shall be treated 15 as an application for reactivation of an expired license under 16 section 286-107.5. The examiner of drivers shall, upon receipt 17 of the request, furnish the applicant with all necessary forms

1 and instructions. An application for renewal made by electronic 2 or digital means or by mail pursuant to this subsection shall be 3 accompanied by a statement from a licensed physician, physician 4 assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse certifying that 5 the applicant was examined by the licensed physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse [not] no more 6 7 than six months [prior to] before the expiration date of the 8 applicant's license and that the applicant was found by the 9 examination to have met the physical requirements established by 10 the state director of transportation for the renewal of 11 licenses. The application for renewal by electronic or digital 12 means or by mail shall also be accompanied by: 13 (1) A notarized statement of the applicant certifying that 14 the applicant does not possess any valid license to 15 operate the same or similar category or categories of 16 motor vehicles, issued by another licensing authority 17 (unless the license is concurrently surrendered); and
