
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is a matter of
2 statewide concern that the president of the University of Hawaii
3 serves simultaneously as the chief procurement officer for the
4 University of Hawaii system. The president of the system
5 simultaneously serving as the chief procurement officer leads to
6 inevitable conflicts of interest.

7 The legislature further finds that across the United
8 States, the vast majority of public higher education
9 institutions, including the California State University system,
10 University of Massachusetts system, and University of Oregon
11 system, differentiate between institutional leadership and
12 purchasing when assigning the authority over procurement. While
13 the chief procurement officer for the Colorado State University
14 system possesses authority over system purchasing and
15 procurement as well as direct oversight over Colorado's
16 institutions of higher learning, there were no instances in



1 institutions across the country in which a university president
2 is concurrently named as chief procurement officer.

3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:

4 (1) Designate the vice president for budget and finance
5 and chief financial officer of the University of
6 Hawaii as the chief procurement officer for the
7 University of Hawaii;

8 (2) Appropriate funds to effectuate the transfer of duties
9 of chief procurement officer to the vice president for
10 budget and finance and chief financial officer of the
11 University of Hawaii; and

12 (3) Appropriate funds for repair and maintenance of
13 University of Hawaii campus buildings and
14 infrastructure, as procured by the chief procurement
15 officer of the University of Hawaii.

16 SECTION 2. Section 103D-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

18 "(a) The chief procurement officer for each of the
19 following state entities shall be:

20 (1) The judiciary--the administrative director of the
21 courts;



- 1 (2) The senate--the president of the senate;
- 2 (3) The house of representatives--the speaker of the house
3 of representatives;
- 4 (4) The office of Hawaiian affairs--the chairperson of the
5 board;
- 6 (5) The University of Hawaii-- [~~the president of the~~
7 ~~University of Hawaii;~~] the vice president for budget
8 and finance and chief financial officer of the
9 University of Hawaii;
- 10 (6) The department of education, excluding the Hawaii
11 public library system--the superintendent of
12 education;
- 13 (7) The Hawaii health systems corporation--the chief
14 executive officer of the Hawaii health systems
15 corporation; and
- 16 (8) The remaining departments of the executive branch of
17 the State and all governmental bodies administratively
18 attached to them--the administrator of the state
19 procurement office of the department of accounting and
20 general services."



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 5 year 2024-2025 to effectuate the transfer of duties of chief
 6 procurement officer from the president of the University of
 7 Hawaii to the vice president for budget and finance and chief
 8 financial officer of the University of Hawaii.

9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
 10 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
 14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 15 year 2024-2025 for repair and maintenance of University of
 16 Hawaii campus buildings and infrastructure.

17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
 18 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;
2 provided that the amendments made to section 103D-203(a), Hawaii
3 Revised Statutes, by section 2 of this Act shall not be repealed
4 when that section is reenacted on June 30, 2024, pursuant to
5 section 16 of Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2021.
