SECTION 1. Section 266-19.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

RELATING TO CAPITAL ADVANCEMENT CONTRACTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d) The department of transportation may execute capital
4	advancement contracts pursuant to subsection (a) with a total
5	contract value of $[\$2,000,000]$ $\$5,000,000$ or less without
6	legislative approval. [If the total value of a capital

8	\$2,000,000 then the department of transportation shall obtain
9	legislative approval in the form of the adoption of a concurrent
10	resolution affirming the purpose, project, and contract issuance
11	prior to executing the capital advancement contract.] The total

into by the department pursuant to this section shall not exceed

[\$5,000,000] \$20,000,000 in any [calendar] fiscal year. The
