A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OHANA ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is established one full-time equivalent
- 2 (1.0 FTE) position, to be appropriately titled, within the
- 3 office of the governor, that shall be responsible for the
- 4 deployment of the capital improvement funds appropriated by
- 5 section 3 of this Act; provided that the governor may transfer
- 6 the position to a designated executive branch department or
- 7 agency.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 12 year 2024-2025 for the ohana zones pilot program established
- 13 pursuant to Act 209, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, as amended by
- 14 Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended by Act 235,
- 15 Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, including expenses relating to
- 16 operations, upkeep of facilities, provision of services, and
- 17 administrative costs.

The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of

- 13 201H-36(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, for facilities constructed
- 14 pursuant to section 3 of Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2023."
- 15 SECTION 5. The exemptions enumerated in section 3 of Act
- 16 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, shall apply to ohana zone
- 17 construction pursuant to this Act.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Ohana Zones Pilot Program; Construction; Facilities; General Excise Tax Exemption; Appropriation

Description:

Establishes one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position within the Office of the Governor to be responsible for the deployment of the capital improvement funds appropriated by this Act. Appropriates funds for the ohana zones pilot program for expenses relating to operations, upkeep of facilities, provision of services, administrative costs, and the construction of facilities. Makes the ohana zones pilot program a government assistance program for purposes of a general excise tax exemption. Specifies that certain exemptions shall apply to the ohana zone construction. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
