## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPLAINTS ALLEGING VIOLATIONS OF CAMPAIGN SPENDING LAWS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-403, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$11-403[+] Notice of complaint; opportunity to explain
- 4 or respond to complaint[-]; failure to explain or respond to
- 5 complaint. (a) The commission shall give notice of receipt of
- 6 the complaint and a copy of the complaint to the respondent.
- 7 (b) The respondent may explain or otherwise respond in
- 8 writing to the complaint and explain or otherwise respond to the
- 9 complaint at a meeting promptly noticed by the commission and
- 10 conducted under chapter 92.
- 11 (c) If the respondent fails to explain or otherwise
- 12 respond to the complaint, the commission may treat the failure
- 13 to explain or respond as a rebuttable presumption that a
- 14 violation has occurred. The respondent shall have thirty days
- 15 from the mailing of the complaint under subsection (a) to

- 1 explain or otherwise respond to the complaint before the
- 2 rebuttable presumption takes effect."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

## Report Title:

Hawaii Campaign Spending Commission Package; Complaints; Violations; Rebuttable Presumption

## Description:

Allows the campaign spending commission to treat a respondent's failure to explain or otherwise respond to a complaint alleging a violation of campaign spending laws as a rebuttable presumption that a violation has occurred. Provides the respondent with thirty days from the mailing of the complaint to explain or otherwise respond before the rebuttable presumption takes effect. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
