### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUDGET-RELATED REPORTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37-75, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§37-75 Variance report. Not fewer than thirty days prior 4 to the convening of each regular session [of the legislature], 5 the governor shall submit to the legislature and to each member 6 thereof a report on program performance for the last completed 7 fiscal year and the fiscal year in progress. In format, the 8 report generally shall follow the fiscal requirements portion of 9 the executive budget or budgets. The report shall include: 10 At the lowest level of the program structure, for each (1) 11 program contained in the budget finally approved by 12 the legislature for the last completed fiscal year and the fiscal year in progress: 13 14 A comparison, by the operating and research and (A) 15 development cost categories, of the budgeted expenditures and the actual expenditures for the 16 17 last completed fiscal year and the budgeted

- (B) A comparison, for the operating and research and development cost categories, of the budgeted expenditures and position ceiling and the actual expenditures and positions filled in the last completed fiscal year and a comparison of the budgeted expenditures and the position ceiling for the fiscal year in progress and the actual expenditures and number of positions filled in the first three months of the fiscal year in progress and the estimated expenditures and number of positions expected to be filled in the remaining months of the fiscal year in progress;
- (C) The program size indicators and a comparison of the program size anticipated and the size actually realized in the last completed fiscal year and the program size anticipated and the size estimated for the fiscal year in progress; provided that the governor shall ensure that each program size indicator used herein accurately reflects the current responsibilities of the

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1		applicable program, addresses the current and
2		future needs of the State, and aligns with the
3		information submitted pursuant to sections 37-71
4		and 37-72 by reviewing and updating the most
5		recently used program size indicators, as
6		necessary;
7	(D)	The effectiveness measures and a comparison of
8		the level of effectiveness anticipated and the
9		level actually attained in the last completed
10		fiscal year and the level of effectiveness
11		anticipated and the level estimated for the
12		fiscal year in progress; provided that the
13		governor shall ensure that each effectiveness
14		measure used herein accurately reflects the
15		current responsibilities of the applicable
16		program, addresses the current and future needs
17		of the State, and aligns with the information
18		submitted pursuant to sections 37-71 and 37-72 by
19		reviewing and updating the most recently used
20		effectiveness measures, as necessary; and
21	(E)	A narrative explanation of the significant
22		differences for the last completed fiscal year in

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1			each of the comparisons made in subparagraphs
2			(A), (B), (C), and (D), including an explanation
3			of the basis upon which the original estimates
4			were made and the reasons why the estimates
5			proved accurate or inaccurate, and a statement of
6			what the actual experience portends for the
7			future of the program in terms of costs, size,
8			and effectiveness;
9		prov	ided that expenditure amounts in the comparisons
10		shal	l be shown to the nearest thousand dollars;
11	(2)	Appr	opriate summaries at each level of the state
12		prog	ram structure for each major grouping of programs
13		enco	mpassed therein, showing:
14		(A)	A comparison of the total budgeted expenditure
15			and the total actual expenditure for the last
16			completed fiscal year and the total budgeted
17			expenditure and the total estimated expenditure
18			for the fiscal year in progress; provided that
19			the expenditure amounts shall be shown to the
20			nearest thousand dollars;
21		(B)	The effectiveness measures and a comparison of
22			the level of effectiveness anticipated and the

1	level actually attained in the last completed
2	fiscal year and the level of effectiveness
3	anticipated and the level estimated for the
4	fiscal year in progress; and
5	(C) A narrative explanation summarizing the major
6	reasons for the differences in the comparisons
7	made for the last completed fiscal year in
8	subparagraphs (A) and (B); and
9	(3) A narrative explanation of the significant variations
10	in capital improvement costs; provided that capital
11	improvement project variances shall be referenced to
12	the six-year program and financial plan, which shall
13	contain the information specified in
14	section 37-69(d)(1)(K)."
15	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Governor; Budget-Related Reports; Variance Reports; Program Size Indicators; Effectiveness Measures; Reviews; Updates

### Description:

Requires the Governor to ensure that the Governor's variance reports accurately reflect the current responsibilities of certain state programs, address the current and future needs of the State, and align with budget-related submittals. (SD2)
