## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS-IN-AID.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d) [ $\pm f$ ] Beginning July 1, 2024, if a grant is used by an
4	organization for the acquisition of land $[, when]$ and the
5	organization discontinues the activities or services on the land
6	acquired for which the grant was awarded [and disposes], prior
7	to the organization's disposition of the land in fee simple or
8	by lease, the organization shall [negotiate]:
9	(1) Obtain authorization of the legislature by concurrent
10	resolution to dispose of the land in fee simple or by
11	<pre>lease; and</pre>
12	(2) Negotiate with the expending agency for a lump sum or
13	installment repayment to the State of the amount of
14	the grant used for the acquisition of the land. This
15	restriction shall be registered, recorded, and indexed
16	in the bureau of conveyances or with the assistant
17	registrar of the land court as an encumbrance on the

1	property. Amounts received from the repayment of a
2	grant under this subsection shall be deposited into
3	the general fund."
4	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
