- 4 provided that section 2 shall be repealed on July 1, 2027]."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Description:

Repeals the sunset date of section 2 of Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, making permanent the requirement that the Hawaii Medical Board issue licenses in four levels of emergency response practice in counties with a population of five hundred thousand or greater and the creation of an additional licensure category for emergency medical technicians 1 who are certified at a higher practice level than emergency medical technicians but do not provide ambulance services. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
