BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 8 SECTION 2. Section 11-391, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) The fine for violation of this section, if assessed
- 11 by the commission, shall not exceed \$25 for each advertisement
- 12 that lacks the information required by this section or provides
- 13 prohibited information, and shall not exceed an aggregate amount
- of \$5,000[-]; provided that any violation of this section by a
- 15 noncandidate committee, if assessed by the commission, shall be
- 16 no less than \$150 for each advertisement that lacks the
- 17 information required by this section or provides prohibited
- 18 information."

- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
