A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1.	The	legislature	finds	that	the	school
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- 2 facilities authority carries out an important mission to ensure
- 3 the development, planning, and construction of all public
- 4 schools in the State. By ensuring that each public school's
- 5 facilities provide students, educators, and communities with
- 6 high quality and healthy learning environments, the school
- 7 facilities authority actively supports public education.
- 8 However, for the school facilities authority to fulfill its
- 9 mission to support public education in the State, the school
- 10 facilities authority requires effective leadership.
- 11 The legislature further finds that other agencies
- 12 administratively attached to the department of education, such
- 13 as the executive office on early learning, the charter school
- 14 commission, and the libraries, require their respective boards
- 15 to appoint their executive director. However, the school
- 16 facilities authority executive director is appointed by the
- 17 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate. As a

- 1 result, the school facilities authority is not consistent with
- 2 other similar agencies. To promote uniformity, the school
- 3 facilities authority executive director should be appointed by
- 4 the members of the authority.
- 5 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to authorize the
- 6 school facilities authority to appoint its executive director
- 7 and evaluate their performance annually.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1702, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) The authority shall [employ] appoint an executive
- 11 director exempt from chapters 76 and 89. [The governor shall
- 12 appoint the executive director in the manner prescribed in
- 13 section 26-34; provided that the executive director's term shall
- 14 be for six years, which shall commence on the day the senate
- 15 advises and consents to the executive director's nomination and
- 16 the executive director shall not be limited in the number of
- 17 terms served. If a vacancy occurs during a term, the governor
- 18 shall appoint an interim executive director whose appointment
- 19 shall expire if the senate does not advise and consent to the
- 20 nomination of an executive director at the next regular session
- 21 of the legislature after the vacancy occurs.] The authority

- 1 shall evaluate the executive director on an annual basis. The
- 2 salary of the executive director shall be set by the school
- 3 facilities board and the executive director shall be included in
- 4 any benefit program generally applicable to the officers and
- 5 employees of the State."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
