RELATING TO GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1 | SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require public |
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| 2 | access to travel reports for individual representatives of |
| 3 | departments and agencies acting in an official capacity on |
| 4 | behalf of the State. |
| 5 | SECTION 2. Chapter 40, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended |
| 6 | by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately |
| 7 | designated and to read as follows: |
| 8 | "§40- Travel report; departments and agencies of the |
| 9 | State. Travel reports submitted by a state employee, officer, |
| 10 | or other representative of any department or agency in |
| 11 | connection with out-of-state and intra-state travel engaged in |
| 12 | for purposes of official state business shall be made available |
| 13 | for public review on the comptroller's website; provided that |
| 14 | personally identifiable information of each individual shall be |
| 15 | kept private." |
| 16 | SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general |
| 17 | revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much |



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1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 2 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 3 2024-2025 to implement and manage digital and searchable public 4 access to travel reports from departments and agencies of the 5 State.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
7 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024;
10 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
