A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require public
- 2 access to travel reports for individual representatives of
- 3 departments and agencies acting in an official capacity on
- 4 behalf of the State.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 40, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 6 by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
- 7 designated and to read as follows:
- 8 "§40- Travel report; departments and agencies of the
- 9 State. Travel reports submitted by a state employee, officer,
- 10 or other representative of any state department or agency,
- 11 including the judiciary and university of Hawaii, in connection
- 12 with out-of-state and intra-state travel where the travel was
- 13 engaged in for purposes of official state business, shall be
- 14 made available for public review on the comptroller's website;
- 15 provided that personally identifiable information of each
- 16 individual shall be kept private and excluded from the reports."

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2024-2025 to implement and manage digital and searchable public
- 6 access to travel reports from departments and agencies of the
- 7 State.
- 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 9 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112;
- 12 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
