A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCESSIVE NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation, in
- 2 conjunction with any county having a population greater than
- 3 five hundred thousand, shall develop and implement a pilot
- 4 program to use noise detection traffic cameras to address
- 5 excessive traffic noise in urban areas of each participating
- 6 county.
- 7 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 8 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 9 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 10 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the state highway
- 12 fund the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much thereof as may be
- 13 necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the same sum or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
- 15 purposes of this Act.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.



- 1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023, and
- 2 shall be repealed on December 31, 2025.
