A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCESSIVE NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation, in
- 2 conjunction with any county with a population greater than five
- 3 hundred thousand persons, shall develop a pilot program to use
- 4 noise detection traffic cameras to address excessive traffic
- 5 noise in urban areas of the county.
- 6 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 7 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 8 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 9 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 14 year 2024-2025 for the purposes of this Act.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050, and
- 2 be repealed on December 31, 2025.

Description:

Appropriates funds for the Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the counties, to develop a pilot program to use noise detection traffic cameras to address excessive traffic noise in urban areas in counties with a population greater than five hundred thousand persons. Requires submitting a report to the Legislature. Sunsets 12/31/2025. Takes effect 7/1/2050. (SD1)
