A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE ACCESS THROUGH REMOTE TESTIMONY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that temporary 2 arrangements implemented due to the coronavirus disease 2019 3 (COVID-19) pandemic have led to vastly expended public access to 4 the legislative process through the use of technology that 5 allows for remote participation in legislative hearings. In the past, the State's unique geography posed particular challenges 6 7 for residents of the counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui, which 8 made participation in the state legislative process time-9 consuming and costly. In addition, demands on the time of residents of all islands, such as work and family obligations, 10 11 made travel to the state capitol to testify at a legislative 12 proceeding difficult. The lack of remote access also 13 disenfranchised persons with disabilities who live on all 14 islands.

15 The legislature concludes that the emergence of COVID-1916 and temporary rules that enabled the public to participate via17 live, real-time remote testimony should be made permanent. The
