A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE CAPITOL TOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TON 1. Chapter 21G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§21</u>	G- State capitol tours program. There shall be
5	established within the public access room a state capitol tours	
6	program to be administered and facilitated by the office, and	
7	which shall include in-person and self-guided walking tours as	
8	well as virtual tours of the Hawaii state capitol building;	
9	provided that:	
10	(1)	Paper brochures and information about the virtual tour
11		website shall also be made available to the public
12		whether on an in-person guided tour or a self-guided
13		walking tour; and
14	(2)	Administration of virtual tours of the capitol shall
15		include maintenance and regular updating of a virtual
16		tour website."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 5 year 2024-2025 for establishment of one full-time equivalent
- 6 (1.0 FTE) position within the legislative reference bureau's
- 7 public access room to conduct and host capitol tours.
- 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the legislative
- 9 reference bureau for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
