BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$396- Workforce safety and health special fund;
- 5 establishment; purposes. (a) There is established within the
- 6 state treasury the workforce safety and health special fund, to
- 7 be administered by the department, into which shall be
- 8 deposited:
- 9 (1) Fees collected pursuant to section 396-5.1;
- 10 (2) All civil penalties collected pursuant to
- 11 section 396-10; and
- 12 (3) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.
- 13 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the
- 14 workforce safety and health special fund shall become part of
- 15 the special fund.
- (b) Moneys in the workforce safety and health special fund
- 17 shall be expended by the department for expenses of the Hawaii



occupational safety and health division, except for expenses 1 prohibited by state law, federal law, or federal grant 2 3 agreements. 4 (c) The unencumbered balance of the workforce safety and 5 health special fund exceeding \$ at the end of each 6 fiscal year shall be deposited into the general fund on or about 7 June 30 of each year." 8 SECTION 2. Section 371-12.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as 10 follows: 11 "[{]\$371-12.5[}] Labor law enforcement special fund; 12 establishment; purposes. (a) There is established in the state 13 treasury the labor law enforcement special fund into which shall 14 be deposited: All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-9.7; 15 (1)16 (2) All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-10; 17 [(3) All civil penalties assessed pursuant to section 18 396-10; 19 (4)] (3) Moneys appropriated by the legislature to the 20 fund; and

[+(5)] (4) Any income and capital gains earned by the fund."

- 6 SECTION 4. Section 396-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by amending subsection (p) to read as follows:
- 8 "(p) All civil penalties collected pursuant to this
- 9 section shall be deposited into the [labor law enforcement]
- 10 workforce safety and health special fund [-] established pursuant
- 11 to section 396-___."
