A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN CULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that native Hawaiian
- 2 culture is the foundation of all aspects of life in Hawaii.
- 3 This culture influences Hawaii's government, businesses, tourism
- 4 industry, families, and individuals. The legislature recognizes
- 5 that despite the prevalence of this cultural foundation, there
- 6 are no public spaces dedicated to the practice and perpetuation
- 7 of Hawaiian culture.
- 8 The legislature believes that Hawaiian cultural centers may
- 9 serve as places where residents and visitors may learn about
- 10 Hawaiian culture, history, tradition, and practices.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 12 (1) Require the office of Hawaiian affairs to establish
- and maintain no fewer than Hawaiian cultural
- 14 centers within the State;
- 15 (2) Require the office of Hawaiian affairs to submit
- 16 reports to the legislature regarding the office's
- 17 compliance with this Act; and

2	first Hawaiian cultural center.		
3	SECTION 2. Chapter 10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended		
4	by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated		
5	and to read as follows:		
6	"§10- Hawaiian cultural centers; statewide.	(a) No	
7	later than , the office of Hawaiian affairs		
8	shall establish and maintain no fewer than Hawaiian		
9	cultural centers within the State.		
10	(b) Each Hawaiian cultural center shall:		
11	(1) Be dedicated to Hawaiian culture and histo	ry,	
12	emphasizing the particular geographic loca	tion of the	
13	<pre>center;</pre>		
14	(2) Contain both static and interactive displa	ys and	
15	exhibits;		
16	(3) Offer classes in Hawaiian chanting, dancing	g, music,	
17	language, and other cultural practices on	a regular,	
18	ongoing basis; and		
19	(4) Serve as a place where the public may gather and hold		
20	celebrations."		

1	SECTION 3. No later than twenty days prior to the		
2	convening of the regular sessions of 2024 and 2026, the board of		
3	trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs shall submit to the		
4	legislature reports that include:		
5	(1) The status of the office's compliance with this Act;		
6	(2) The estimated costs of the planning, design, and		
7	construction of Hawaiian cultural centers;		
8	(3) Any proposed legislation; and		
9	(4) Any other relevant information.		
10	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the		
13	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
14	2024-2025 for the planning and design of one Hawaiian cultural		
15	center.		
16	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of		
17	Hawaiian affairs for the purposes of this Act.		
18	SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.		
19	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
