## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the protection of
- 2 the State's natural resources is of paramount importance.
- 3 Pursuant to article XI, section 2, of the Hawaii State
- 4 Constitution, the legislature has the authority to "vest in one
- 5 or more executive boards or commissions powers for the
- 6 management of natural resources owned or controlled by the
- 7 State". Presently, the department of land and natural
- 8 resources, under the direction of the board of land and natural
- 9 resources, remains as the principal agency tasked with natural
- 10 resource management. However, other executive boards or
- 11 commissions may share overlapping responsibilities related to
- 12 natural resource management.
- 13 With the enactment of Act 255, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022
- 14 (Act 255), the legislature vested certain natural resource
- 15 management powers to the newly established Mauna Kea stewardship
- 16 and oversight authority for lands identified and defined as
- 17 "Mauna Kea lands" pursuant to Act 255. Following a five-year



- 1 transition period, the Mauna Kea stewardship and oversight
- 2 authority will acquire the powers and duties previously held by
- 3 the board of land and natural resources pursuant to chapter 171,
- 4 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the land use commission pursuant to
- 5 chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as pertaining to the Mauna
- 6 Kea lands. However, this transition period is unclear as to the
- 7 board of land and natural resources and department of land and
- 8 natural resources' responsibility for lands within the state
- 9 conservation district, including lands identified and defined as
- 10 "Mauna Kea lands". Therefore, further clarification between the
- 11 Mauna Kea stewardship and oversight authority's and the board of
- 12 land and natural resources' jurisdiction is needed to protect
- 13 the State's precious natural resources.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify that all
- 15 powers and duties of the board of land and natural resources and
- 16 the department of land and natural resources pursuant to
- 17 chapters 183C and 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, pertaining to
- 18 areas designated under the state conservation district on Mauna
- 19 Kea lands, will be retained and will not be transferred to the
- 20 Mauna Kea stewardship and oversight authority upon the
- 21 expiration of the five-year transition period.

I	SECTION 2. Section 1830-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	" [+]	§183C-3[] Powers and duties of the board and
4	departmen	t. (a) The board and department shall:
5	(1)	Maintain an accurate inventory of lands classified
6		within the state conservation district by the state
7		land use commission, pursuant to chapter 205;
8	(2)	Identify and appropriately zone those lands classified
9		within the conservation district;
10	(3)	Adopt rules, in compliance with chapter 91 which shall
11		have the force and effect of law;
12	(4)	Set, charge, and collect reasonable fees in an amount
13		sufficient to defray the cost of processing
14		applications for zoning, use, and subdivision of
15		conservation lands;
16	(5)	Establish categories of uses or activities on
17		conservation lands, including allowable uses or
18		activities for which no permit shall be required;
19	(6)	Establish restrictions, requirements, and conditions
20		consistent with the standards set forth in this
21		chapter on the use of conservation lands; and

1	(/) Establish and enforce land use regulations on		
2	conservation district lands including the collection		
3	of fines for violations of land use and terms and		
4	conditions of permits issued by the department.		
5	(b) All powers and duties of the board and department		
6	pursuant to this chapter and chapter 171, pertaining to areas		
7	designated under the state conservation district on Mauna Kea		
8	lands, shall be retained and shall not be transferred to the		
9	Mauna Kea stewardship and oversight authority upon the		
10	expiration of the five-year transition period pursuant to Act		
11	255, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022."		
12	SECTION 3. Section 195H-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
13	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:		
14	"(b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, all powers		
15	and duties of the board of land and natural resources pursuant		
16	to chapter 171, and the land use commission pursuant to chapter		
17	205, concerning permits, dispositions, land use approvals, and		
18	any other approvals pertaining to the Mauna Kea lands are		
19	transferred to the authority upon the expiration of the		
20	transition period; provided that the transfer of such powers and		
21	duties from the board of land and natural resources and the land		

- 1 use commission may occur earlier, upon approval of the
- 2 authority, the board of land and natural resources, and the land
- 3 use commission. Upon the expiration of the transition period,
- 4 the authority shall carry out the powers and duties otherwise
- 5 conferred upon the board of land and natural resources pursuant
- 6 to chapter 171, and the land use commission pursuant to chapter
- 7 205, with regard to permits, dispositions, land use approvals,
- 8 and any other approvals pertaining to the Mauna Kea lands [-];
- 9 provided that all powers and duties of the board of land and
- 10 natural resources and the department of land and natural
- 11 resources pursuant to chapters 183C and 171, pertaining to areas
- 12 designated under the state conservation district on Mauna Kea
- 13 lands, shall be retained and shall not be transferred to the
- 14 Mauna Kea stewardship and oversight authority upon the
- 15 expiration of the five-year transition period."
- 16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

Mauna Kea Stewardship and Oversight Authority; Board of Land and Natural Resources; Conservation District
