A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WAHIAWA IRRIGATION SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

2 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Wahiawa irrigation system is a critical irrigation system providing 3 water to farmers in Wahiawa, Waialua, and Haleiwa on the island 4 5 of Oahu. Built by the Waialua Sugar Company, the Wahiawa 6 irrigation system was created with a dam and freshwater 7 reservoir fed by the north fork and south fork of the Kaukonahua 8 stream. The dam is essential to agriculture as the water in the 9 reservoir provides irrigation to farmers in Wahiawa, Waialua, 10 and Haleiwa. The reservoir also provides a venue for 11 recreational activities for the surrounding community and the 12 State.

13 The legislature further finds that Dole Food Company, Inc., 14 has listed the irrigation system for sale for \$20,000,000. The 15 Dole portion of the system includes the Wahiawa reservoir, 16 Wahiawa dam, and ditch system. The spillway, owned by 17 Sustainable Hawaii, LLC, is also an integral component of the

irrigation system. Dole has offered to donate its interests to
 the State of Hawaii in exchange for the State's agreement to
 repair the spillway to meet and maintain dam safety standards.
 It is in the interest of the public for the State to acquire the
 Wahiawa irrigation system and preserve the system for public
 access and the agriculture industry.

7 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of 8 agriculture, department of land and natural resources, and 9 agribusiness development corporation to acquire the Wahiawa 10 irrigation system, on terms negotiated and agreed upon by the 11 office of the governor, and to purchase, repair, and maintain 12 the associated spillway.

PART II

SECTION 2. (a) The office of the governor shall negotiate site with Wahiawa Water Company, Inc.; Dole Food Company, Inc.; Sustainable Hawaii, LLC; or other appropriate owner for the State's fee simple acquisition of the Wahiawa irrigation system.
(b) The department of land and natural resources may acquire from Wahiawa Water Company, Inc., or Dole Food Company, Inc., on terms agreed upon by the office of the governor, the

The sums appropriated shall be expended by the agribusiness 1 2 development corporation for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 4 or so 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 7 year 2024-2025 for the department of land and natural resources 8 to manage and maintain its acquired portion of the Wahiawa 9 irrigation system and for the establishment of four full-time 10 equivalent (4.0 FTE) positions to effectuate these purposes. 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 12 13 PART IV SECTION 7. The appropriations made for the capital 14 15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at 16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are 17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations 18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2025, shall lapse as of that date. 19 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
