A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND USE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State and
2	counties have not made effective use of the state rural land use
3	district, one of four districts established by the state land
4	use law in chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Currently,
5	there are 10,454 acres in the rural district, which amount to
6	0.3 per cent of all lands in the State, and there are no rural
7	district lands on Oahu. Marginal agricultural lands in the
8	agricultural land use district are being used for rural
9	lifestyle farms and residences with no farm activity, which
10	increases the cost of land in the agricultural district used for
11	bona fide farming operations.
12	The legislature further finds that there is potential for
13	greater use of the rural district to differentiate rural
14	communities and lifestyle farms from working or commercial
15	agricultural lands and to enable better protection of productive
16	agricultural lands and the open space character of Hawaii's

- 1 would enable better land use management of existing rural
- 2 settlements and rural centers and residential dwellings engaged
- 3 in subsistence or lifestyle agriculture, which are not
- 4 explicitly permitted in the agricultural district.
- 5 The office of planning and sustainable development
- 6 completed a state land use review of districts report in January
- 7 2022 pursuant to section 205-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
- 8 review found that the potential for preserving much of Hawaii's
- 9 open space, rural communities, and working lands may be realized
- 10 by redefining the policy framework for the rural district and
- 11 facilitating the reclassification of lands from the agricultural
- 12 to the rural district to accommodate lower-density rural
- 13 settlement patterns and subsistence farming lifestyles.
- 14 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:
- 15 (1) Require the office of planning and sustainable
- 16 development to perform a study to refine rural
- district policies and make recommendations to
- 18 facilitate the reclassification of lands from the
- agricultural district to the rural district; and
- 20 (2) Appropriate funds for the study.

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1	SECTION 2. The office of planning and sustainable		
2	developme	nt shall perform a study to assess the rural district	
3	framework	within the land use law and make recommendations for	
4	revisions	to rural district policies and permissible uses within	
5	the rural	district. The study shall include:	
6	(1)	A legal analysis of regulatory issues and safeguards	
7		that must be addressed to facilitate the	
8		reclassification of lands from the agricultural	
9		district to the rural district; and	
10	(2)	Recommendations for legislation that would be needed	
11		to address the issues and safeguards identified in	
12		paragraph (1).	
13	SECTION 3. In performing the study required by this Act,		
14	the office of planning and sustainable development shall		
15	coordinate its efforts with the land use commission, department		
16	of agriculture, and county planning departments. The office of		
17	planning and sustainable development shall engage community		
18	stakeholders, including farming interests and interested members		
19	of the general public, in the development of study		
20	recommendations.		

1	SECTION 4. The office of planning and sustainable	
2	development shall submit:	
3	(1) An interim report of its findings and recommendations,	
4	including any proposed legislation, to the legislature	
5	no later than twenty days prior to the convening of	
6	the regular session of 2024; and	
7	(2) A final report of its findings and recommendations,	
8	including any proposed legislation, to the legislature	
9	no later than twenty days prior to the convening of	
10	the regular session of 2025.	
11	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general	
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so	
13	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and	
14	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal	
15	year 2024-2025 for the office of planning and sustainable	
16	development to perform the study and complete all required	
17	reports pursuant to this Act.	
18	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department	
19	of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes	
20	of this Act.	

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1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
